

Crackers Safety Tips - Light Up with Care

General Safety Guidelines

- Always buy crackers from licensed and trusted sellers.
- Read instructions and labels before use.
- Store fireworks in a cool, dry place away from heat or flame.
- Always light crackers in open outdoor areas.
- Use a long stick or sparkler to light crackers safely.

Children & Fireworks

- Children should use fireworks only under adult supervision.
- Educate children about the dangers of misuse.
- Keep a bucket of water or fire extinguisher nearby.

Clothing & Safety

- Wear cotton clothes - avoid synthetic fabrics.
- Use closed shoes to protect your feet.

Never Do This!

- Don't relight a dud cracker - soak it in water.
- Don't light crackers near dry grass, vehicles, or flammable materials.
- Don't carry fireworks in your pockets.
- Don't burst crackers inside closed rooms or near windows.

First Aid Basics

- In case of burns, rinse the affected area with clean cold water.
- Seek medical help immediately for serious injuries.
- Have emergency numbers readily available.

After Celebration

- Clean up all used crackers and dispose of them responsibly.
- Be mindful of your neighbors and pets.
